

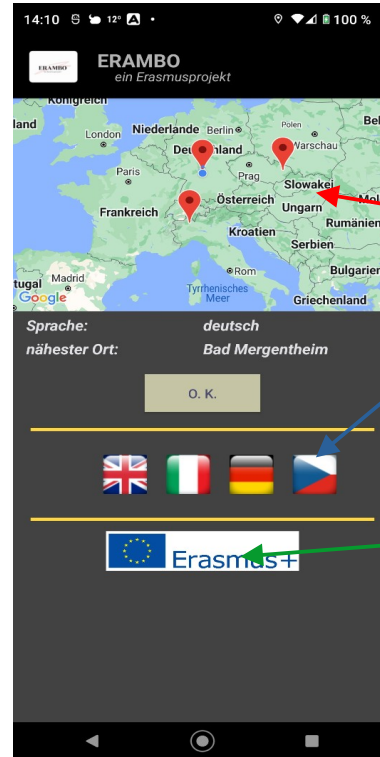
Erambo – an Erasmusproject

The blue point marks your current location.

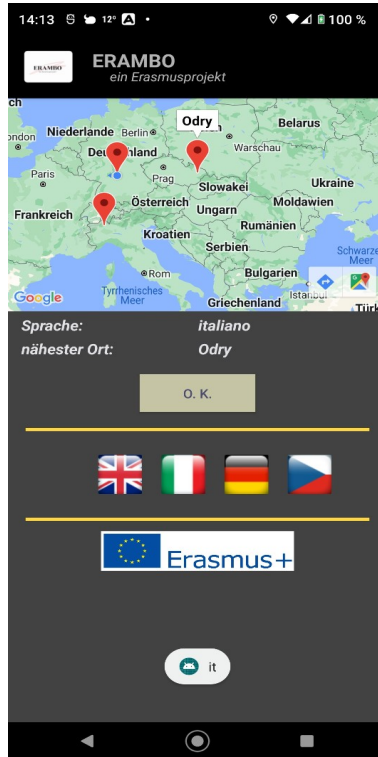


Now you can select the

you have to click here.

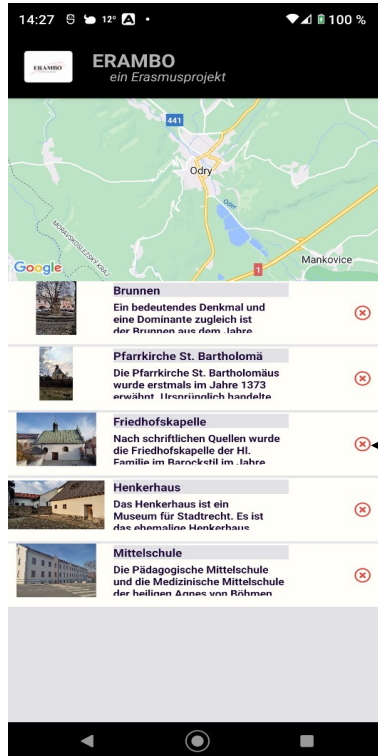
Select location and language

the language italian.

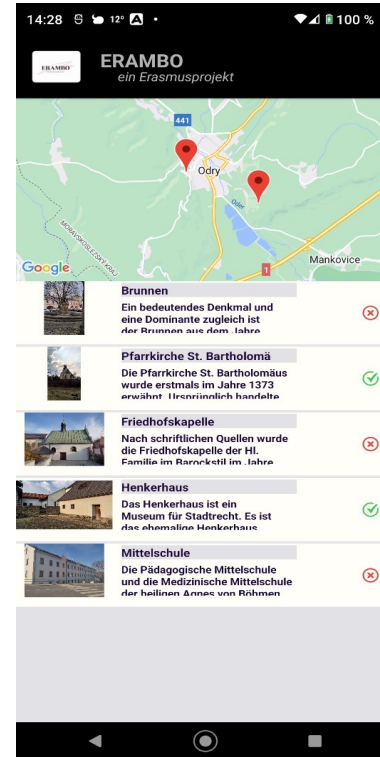


Sightlist

We get all sights of Odry in a listbox. For every sight we can see a picture and a short discription.



If you want to see the location of the sight in the map, you can mark it with a click on this small button.

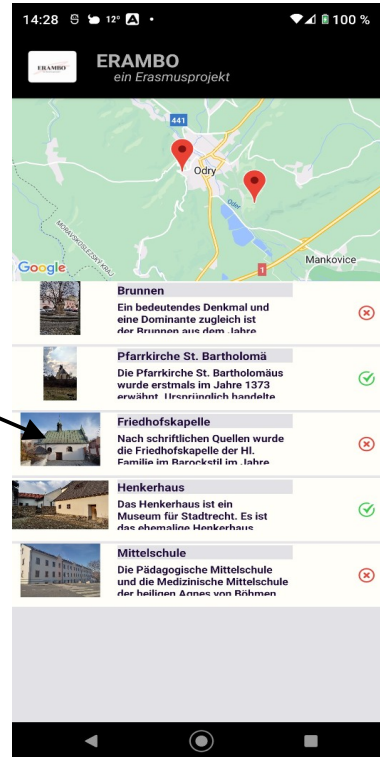


The location of the marked sights are now shown in the map

and the button changed color and symbol.

Sightlist

If you want to have more information of the sight, you can click on the small picture on the left side.



Sight long description

If the picture is too small for you, click on it and you get a big picture, on which you can see more details.



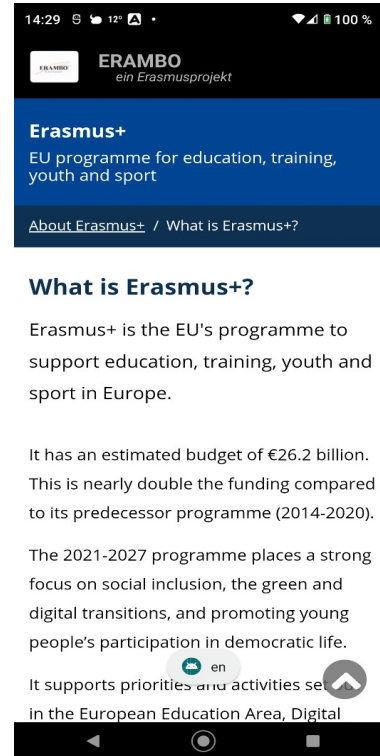
Big picture of a sight
